Travelling to Sassari – North Sardinia

By boat: Ports of Porto Torres and Olbia

By plane: Airports of Alghero-Fertilia and Olbia

By bus: Bus terminal is located in Via Padre Ziranu (c.a. 400 m from the Halls of Residence in V. Michele Coppino and from the International Office in Via-Largo Macao)

Prior to their arrival students should notify the International Office and the ESN via email (let us know how, when and what time you will be arriving in Sassari).

Accommodation

Each semester, ERSU, the Regional Office for University Students, reserves 20 places for incoming Erasmus Exchange students. Students can take up accommodation c/o the university Halls of Residence at a special rate. University accommodation is allocated on a first-come first-served basis, longer-term students are also given priority. The International Office notifies ERSU of successful applicants for this type of accommodation. ERSU also provides temporary accommodation c/o the Student Hall of Residence (students arriving before 15 September), or a 3-night stay at a local hotel (for later arrivals) where no accommodation is available in the Halls of Residence.

Catering facilities

There are two university canteens in Sassari: Via dei Mille and Via Padre Manzella. Erasmus students can have their meals there at a discount price of € 3.06 per meal. The use of these facilities is limited to card holders – cards are issued by ERSU on the basis of incoming Erasmus students lists as provided by the International Office every semester.

Italian Language intensive courses

The University Centre for Language Teaching (C.L.A.) organises special intensive courses for foreign learners of Italian. This year courses will run from September to May.

Public Transport in the city

Monthly tickets priced € 15.00 are available to both full-time commuting students and Erasmus exchange students. These special-rate tickets are offered by ERSU and ATP, the local Public Transport Agency, and they give unlimited travel on city bus and tram services.

Social life, culture and sports

ERSU promotes social cultural and sport activities for incoming Erasmus students. In conjunction with CUS, the University Sports Centre, ERSU offers free access to the university sports centres, special rates for all activities promoted by CUS in sport venues in and out of Sassari. CUS membership is required: applicants should present a valid certificate from their GP. Cards are valid for 1 year and they are priced 7€.

Healthcare and medical service

A GP is available for commuting and incoming Erasmus students in Via Padre Manzella. Healthcare and GP medical service are free of charge. Students may obtain certificates for sport activities from here.

Information Packs

Information packs with detailed information about Sassari and its university will be available to all incoming Erasmus students through ERSU staff.
